

## Boston Fire Department Fire Investigation Unit Motor Vehicle Fire Report DFS Form 33C

In order to process a Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Fire Services Burned/Recovered Motor Vehicle Report(Form FP 33C) the <u>owner of record</u> must come, in person, to the Fire Investigation Unit located at 920 Massachusetts Avenue, Boston, MA 02118 and complete Form 33C and Form 33D. The following documentation is <u>Required</u> to complete these forms.

## 1. Drivers License

- 2. Vehicle Title or Proof of Payments for past three(3) months
  - 3. Registration
  - 4. Coverage Selections Page of Insurance Policy

If the vehicle was stolen and set on fire, the following additional documentation is required:
